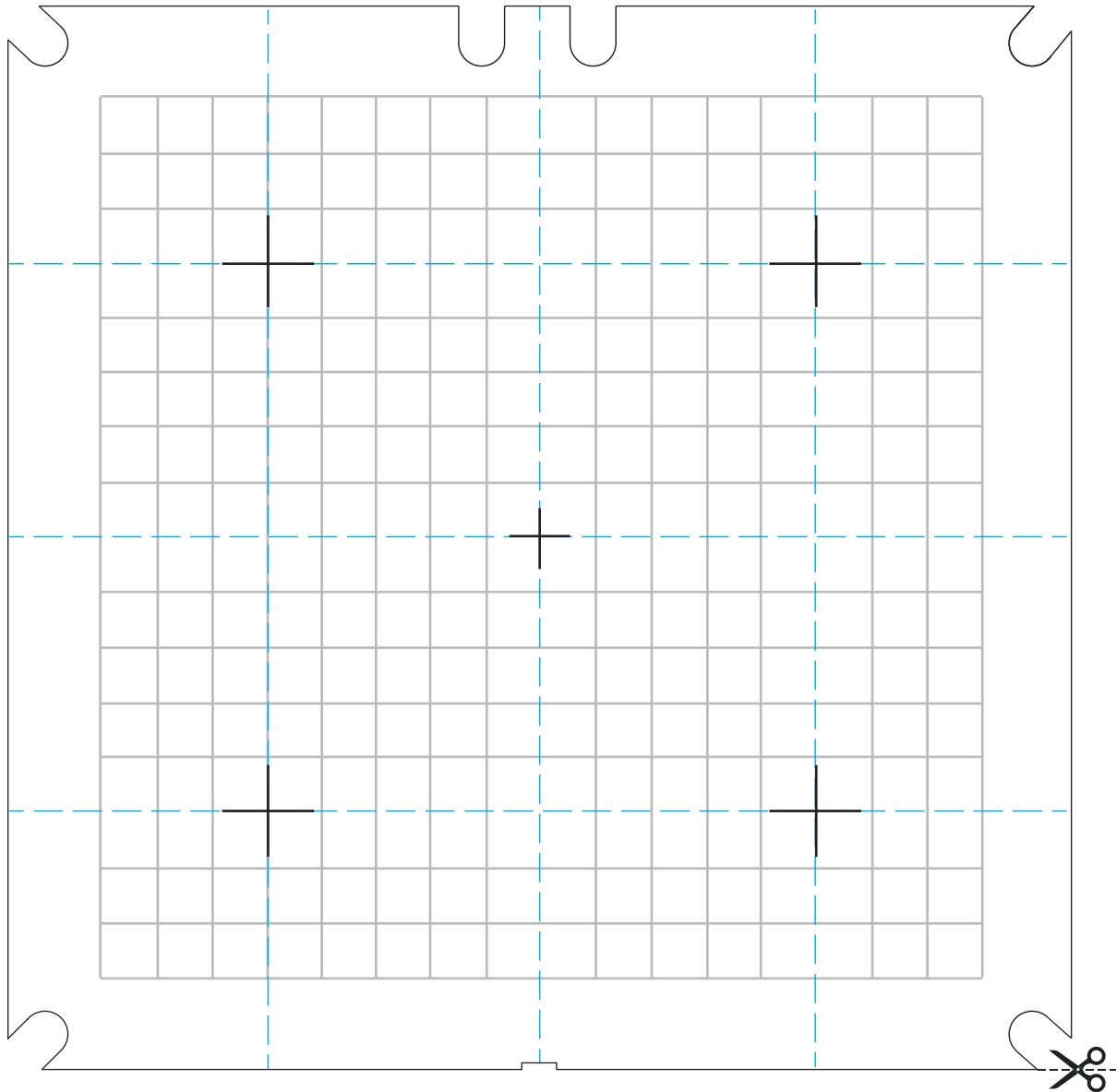



Create Your Own Designs! Blank Template



Fold Line 

Cut Lines 



Materials Needed:

Scissors

Pencil with eraser

Colored pencils

Black colored pencil or

black felt tip marker

Optional: Lego® bricks
for more colors.

1. Using scissors, follow the outline (outside edge) to cut out the template.
2. Using a pencil, draw your picture inside the grid, along the grid lines.
3. Using colored pencils, crayons or markers that match your bricks, color your drawing.
4. Fold your template along a dashed blue line and cut the lines in the crosshairs. Unfold paper. Continue in this manner until all of the crosshairs have been cut.
5. Place your template under your clear, studded baseplate so that you can see your picture through the front. Now secure it on the back at the corners with the clear pegs and hanger piece. Now you're ready to start stacking bricks up to 3 bricks high! Tip: use the eraser side of your pencil to push down the bricks.

Extra activity: Replicate your 3D image in 2D (as pixels) on a fresh template for another child to follow, but this time, add the numbers that correspond to the height of your bricks. Be sure to use the color of the top brick in each stack on your drawing and include any changes that you made during the building process.!
